Bill Summary

The CCS for SB 1486 requires that the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) shall initiate a separate request for proposals (RFP) for the construction of a suitable facility to house juveniles within its custody to replace a facility with capacity in excess of 125 available secure beds. Authorizes OJA to enter into a lease-purchase agreement for construction or authorization of such facility.

The bill further requires that OJA shall initiate a separate RFP for the razing of property needed to construct the facility specified above. Grants the Board authorization to enter into a contract for the razing of such property. The measure also requires that OJA shall initiate a separate RFP for the management and operation of the facility specified above. Grants the Board authorization to enter into a contract for the management and operation of such a facility.

Additionally, the measure states the intent of the Legislature that upon the conclusion of any lease-purchase term, the title of such facility will be transferred to OJA the lease-purchase agreement. Authorizes the Board to promulgate rules and establish procedures necessary to implement the provisions of the act. Specifies that Department of Central Services shall work in conjunction with OJA to implement provisions of this act.

Fiscal Analysis

There are no appropriations or expenditures associated with the provisions of this measure. The fiscal impact of the bill is \$0.

Long Term Fiscal Considerations

Depending on the state of OJA budget and the details of the RFPs, the Board may choose to implement policy that would significantly effect how the agency is administered in the future
