Bill Summary

The Conference Committee Substitute (CCS) for Senate Bill 1519 authorizes the Scenic Rivers Commission to charge an annual use fee of \$10.00 for each noncommercial, privately owned device or a use fee of \$1.00 per day for all noncommercial, privately owned flotation devices floating upon state-designated scenic rivers. The aforementioned fees apply to the Flint Creek and Illinois River within Adair, Cherokee and Delaware Counties and those portions of Barren Fork Creek located within Cherokee County. Landowners located immediately adjacent to state-designated scenic rivers are not required to pay either fee.

Fiscal Summary

The conference committee substitute for SB 1519 allows the Scenic Rivers Commission to charge a \$10 annual use fee per noncommercial, privately-owned floatation device or a \$1 per day fee for each noncommercial, privately-owned floatation device.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the Commission state that the revenue from the fees levied would be anywhere from \$5,000 to \$15,000 annually, dependent upon the number of annual versus day-use fees.
