- Section 1:** Makes an appropriation of \$500,000 to the agency from General Revenue.
- Section 2:** Budget Limits.
- Section 3:** Redesignates \$500,000 from the Association of South Central Oklahoma Governments to the Commerce Revolving Fund.
- Section 4:** Authorizes administration of the RX for Oklahoma program.
- Section 5:** Provides FTE limit.
- Section 6:** Provides line item budget numbers.
- Section 7:** Directs funding for Community Action Agencies.
- Section 8:** Directs funding for the Head Start Programs.
- Section 9:** Exempts Community Action Agency contracts from the OK Central Purchasing Act.
- Section 10:** Allocates funds to the substate planning districts (COGS).

- Section 11:** Directs funding to the Southeastern Oklahoma State University Small Business Development Centers Network.
- Section 12:** Directs funding to the Oklahoma Development Finance Authority for REI.
- Section 13:** Directs funding to REI for the VANSAT project.
- Section 14:** Directs funding to the Oklahoma Alliance for Manufacturing Excellence.
- Section 15:** Sets requirements for funding being transferred to the Community Development Centers Program Fund.
- Section 16:** Directs funding to the Native American Cultural and Education Authority.
- Section 17:** Directs funding to the Bid Assistance Program/Computer Assisted Technology Transfer (CATT) program.
- Section 18:** Directs funding for the Small Rural Manufacturers Program at Oklahoma State University.
- Section 19:** Directs funding to the Oklahoma Quality Awards Foundation.
- Section 20:** Directs funding to the Education Research and Economic Development Foundation.
- Section 21:** Exempts unanticipated federal funds from expenditure limitations.
- Section 22:** Authorizes transfer of funds. .
- Section 23:** Makes an appropriation.
- Section 24:** Directs funding to ACOG for capital improvements.
- Section 25:** Provides lapse dates.
- Section 26:** Provides effective date.
- Section 27:** Declares an emergency.
