Bill Summary

The committee substitute to Senate Bill 2183 restores the title.

The measure directs the Secretary of the Commissioners of the Land Office to study the possibility of selling some sections of school land while retaining mineral rights and whether that might provide a better benefit to the Commission and the state. The Secretary shall submit a report by December 1, 2011.
