Bill Summary

The first amendment to the proposed committee substitute to Senate Bill 2199 requires the State Board of Education to send the national criminal history record check of teachers employed in Oklahoma schools through the Teach for America Program to the organization.

The proposed committee substitute states that districts may reimburse employees for the cost of a national criminal history record check.

The measure allows boards of education to request from the State Board of Education a national criminal history record check of any employee of the school.

Fiscal Summary

FULLPCS1-AMD1 requires the State Board of Education to send results from a national criminal history check to the Teach for America Program upon the request of a teacher.

Fiscal Analysis
