The 2nd CCS for SB2253 modifies the definition of fireworks; changes the name of Class C Fireworks to Consumer Fireworks; changes the name of Class B Display Fireworks to Display Fireworks and modifies definition; defines novelties; authorizes novelties to be stored, transported and sold; makes certain retail facilities subject to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) regulations; authorizes wholesalers to sell fireworks year round; restricts dates retailers are authorized to sell fireworks from June 15th until July 6th and from December 15th until January 2nd; requires application for permit to display fireworks be in writing and submitted ten days prior to display date; and requires those making application for a permit to display fireworks to have a general liability insurance policy of at least \$1 million.
