**Bill Summary**

Engrossed SB 2259 requires the Director of the Department of Corrections to post on the Department's website and transmit to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House and the Governor a report on the progress of the Department in the use of work release programs, work centers, community corrections centers, intermediate sanctions facilities, halfway houses and transitional living centers to reintegrate offenders.

**Fiscal Summary**

SB2259 requires the Director of the Department of Corrections (DOC) to post an annual report on the agency's website detailing the progress of the Department in meeting the intent of the Legislature regarding the reintegration of nonviolent inmates into society through the use of work release, work centers and halfway houses.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to DOC, the data to be included in the report can be retrieved from the agency's offender management system and offender banking system. DOC estimates the annual cost for staff to gather the data and post the report would be approximately \$4,000.
