Bill Summary

This measure removes obsolete language allowing the Oklahoma Corporation Commission to promulgate rules relating to the single state registration of motor carriers. Tour bus operations are also removed from regulation by the Commission under the International Registration Plan. In addition, the measure specifies that any action taken by the Oklahoma Tax Commission with respect to the International Registration Plan or other compacts or agreements prior to July 1, 2004, is to remain in effect unless altered by the Corporation Commission.

Fiscal Summary

The engrossed version of SB 301 removes provisions relating to the Corporation Commission's authority to promulgate rules regarding the single state registration system, and rules for interstate motor carriers exempt from Interstate Commerce Commission regulations. The measure also removes tour buses from Corporation Commission regulation.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the Corporation Commission state that the provisions of the measure would have no fiscal impact to the Commission or the state.
