Bill Summary

The Committee Substitute to Senate Bill 335 modifies the duties of CLEET to allow CLEET to conduct review and verification of any records relating to the statutory duties of CLEET including the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act. The measure establishes that CLEET is to be considered a governmental law enforcement agency and is charged with completing those functions necessary to ensure the professional training and continuing education of law enforcement officers in the State of Oklahoma. Provides that CLEET is authorized to receive investigative reports, court documents, statements and other information from local, county and state agencies for use in actions related to CLEET certification or licensing. Authorizes CLEET to suspend a certification of a peace officer without prior notice if CLEET finds that the actions of the peace officer may present a danger to the peace officer, the public, a family or household member or involve a crime against a minor. Provides that a peace officer is subject to disciplinary action for abuse of office. Updates language relating to date of implementation.

SB 335 modifies the definition and duties of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET). SB 335 makes CLEET a governmental law enforcement agency, requires CLEET to conduct review and verification of any records relating to the agency's statutory duties and authorizes CLEET to suspend the certification of peace officers under certain conditions.
