Bill Summary

The subcommittee recommendation restores the title for SB354, which modifies the \$50,000 income cap for OHLAP eligibility. Specifically, the student's parents income is to be based on a three year average or the current year, whichever is less.

Fiscal Summary

The subcommittee recommendation for SB 354 calculates the initial \$50,000 income limit for the Oklahoma's Promise Program on a three-year average, or on the current year, whichever is less.

Fiscal Analysis

Though the measure's provisions could lead to a slight increase in the number of students eligible for the scholarship, the State Regents for Higher Education do not feel that that the program will require additional appropriations as a result.
