Bill Summary

The measure amends current statutes regarding authorized payroll deductions for state employees to include payroll deductions for the following: "The payment of any insurance premiums due a private insurance organization, which is regulated by the State Insurance Commission, for an Oklahoma Long-Term Care Partnership Program approved policy pursuant to the Oklahoma Long-Term Care Partnership Act".

The Subcommittee Recommendation for ESB 384 permits payroll deductions, upon the request of a state employee and pursuant to procedures established by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM), for premiums for Oklahoma Long-Term Care Partnership Program approved policies.
