Bill Summary

This measure exempts state environmental agencies and public utilities from being required to release pursuant to any Oklahoma Open Records Act request, any maps, plats, plans or other infrastructure information considered confidential. The measure does, however, require that state environmental agencies and public utilities allow any public body to have access to the information for purposes specifically related to the function of the public body.

Fiscal Summary

The engrossed version of SB 695 provides that state environmental agencies and public utilities are not required to release any information in the form of plans, maps, plats or other infrastructure information which is considered confidential, unless to a state agency who will use the information only for the function of the agency.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials at the Department of Environmental Quality state this measure would have no significant effect on state revenues or expenditures.
