Bill Summary

The Conference Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 888 provides uniformity in the designation and appointment of motor license agents. The measure removes population limitations regarding the appointment of motor license agents so that all appointments and designations are made by the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

Fiscal Summary

The Conference Committee Substitute for SB 888 deletes a population threshold related to appointment procedures for motor license agents and provides that the qualifications and requirements for appointment as an agent shall apply to all areas of the state. The measure removes population limitations regarding the appointment of motor license agents so that all appointments and designations are made by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Finally, the Conference Committee Substitute for SB 88 provides that any motor license agent appointed before the effective date of this act may continue to serve until the agent resigns or is removed.

Fiscal Analysis

The Tax Commission advises that in its present form there is no fiscal impact on state revenues or resources under the provisions of the Conference Committee Substitute SB 888.
