Engrossed SB 902 decreases the legal limit of breath alcohol concentration for persons in physical control of a vessel on Oklahoma waters from ten-hundredths (0.10) to eight-hundredths (0.08). The measure also provides procedures for the testing of persons whom a peace officer has probable cause to believe has operated a vessel while intoxicated.
