Bill Summary

Engrossed SJR11 requires the Oklahoma Legislature to cancel all applications by the Legislature to the United States Congress to call a convention to propose amendments to the U.S. Constitution; urges other state legislatures to do the same; and directs copies of the joint resolution be sent to the Secretary of State, the presiding officers of both houses of all the state legislatures, the President of the U.S. Senate, the Speaker of the U.S. House, Oklahoma's congressional members, and the Administrator of the U.S. General Services Administration. The title is stricken on Engrossed SJR11.

SJR 11, as introduced, rescinds, repeals, cancels, nullifies and withdrawals any previously made and active applications by the Oklahoma Legislature to the Congress of the United States calling for a constitutional convention.
