Bill Summary

The measure requires state agencies to provide a link to their website where all proposed rules can be viewed within three days after publication of notice in the Oklahoma Register. The bill also defines the term of appointments to the Small Business Regulatory Review Committee made by the Speaker of the House.

Fiscal Summary

The 2nd Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1071 modifies notice requirements concerning changes under the Administrative Procedures Act. The measure provides that prior to or within three days after the publication of the notice in "The Oklahoma Register" that an agency shall provide a link to the agency's web site where the proposed rule can be viewed. The measure also modifies appointments to the Small Business Regulatory Review Committee, providing that those initially appointed by the Speaker of the House shall serve for terms ending December 31, 2006. Thereafter, appointed members shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority for four-year terms that expire on December 31 of the fourth year.

Fiscal Analysis

In its present form, the 2nd Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1071 has no significant impact on state revenues or resources.
