Bill Summary

HB1307 provides malpractice protection for physicians who are ring officials at events sanctioned by the Oklahoma Professional Boxing Licensing Act and who administer emergency care to an injured participant. The exceptions to this immunity are gross, willful and/or wanton negligence.

Fiscal Summary

HB 1307, as introduced, is new language related to the Oklahoma Professional Boxing Licensing Act. This legislation will provide limited malpractice protection for any physician, who is a ring official, providing medical services at an amateur or professional athletic event sanctioned pursuant to the Oklahoma Professional Boxing Licensing Act.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1307, as introduced, will have no fiscal impact on appropriated agencies or appropriated funds.

Long Term Fiscal Considerations

Technically, the Oklahoma Professional Boxing Licensing Act was replaced during the 2008 Legislative Session by HB 3070, which changed the name of the aforementioned act to the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Act.
