Bill Summary

HB1412 modifies the definition of false or bogus checks to include “electronic fund transfers.” This bill then requires a court-imposed bogus check fee of \$25, which is to be paid to the victim for each bogus check.

Fiscal Summary

HB 1412, as introduced, imposes a new fee to victims of bogus checks.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1412 requires persons convicted of a bogus check violation pay a \$25 fee for each check to the victim. According to the District Attorneys Council, the additional fee imposed on offenders would provide approximately \$51,000 annually to victims. HB 1412 in its current form has no significant fiscal impact.
