The floor substitute allows for parents, teachers, or a school district to initiate a request for an initial evaluation to determine if a student has a disability. The school district is required to have a procedure in place for documenting such requests, procedures to be followed prior to the beginning of the evaluation, and a time limit for the completion of the evaluation.

The Floor Substitute for HB 2126 contains provisions relating to Special Education determinations, including permission for certain individuals to request a determination, requiring school districts to have a procedure in place for documenting such requests, procedures to be followed prior to the beginning of the evaluation, a time limit for beginning the evaluation process, a time limit in which an evaluation of a student must be completed, and exceptions to this limit.
