Bill Summary

The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for House Bill 3166 requires the committee or subcommittee of the Oklahoma House of Representatives to which legislation primarily related to revenue and taxation is assigned to conduct an annual review and evaluation of each tax credit authorized by state law. Upon completion of the annual review, the committee or subcommittee is then required to make a written report of its findings and include any recommendations for modification or elimination of any tax credit. In addition, the measure requires that such report be submitted to the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives no later than March 1 every year.

HB 3166 requires the members of the committee or subcommittee which is assigned legislation primarily relating to revenue and taxation will:

- conduct an annual review and evaluation of state tax credits; and
- submit (by May 1) a written annual report to the Speaker of the House which includes finding and recommendations for modification or elimination of tax credits.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3166 does not include information relating to the place, date or time the committee or subcommittee will meet. The measure also does not address reimbursement for travel or other costs. If the meetings for reviews are held at the Capital during legislative session, there will be no additional costs. If the meetings are held at other places or times, there is a potential for travel expense or other expenses related to the study.
