Bill Summary

The proposed committee substitute to HB3168 creates the School Testing Scheduling Task Force, which shall review the current statewide assessment system and factors involved in setting the testing window dates for statewide assessments and scheduling of extracurricular activities. The 13-member task force shall make recommendations on the coordination of testing window dates for statewide assessments with the scheduling of extracurricular activities and events in order to avoid conflicts.

The task force shall make a report to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 31, 2010.
