HJR1009 resolves that the Oklahoma Legislature opposes the federal Freedom of Choice Act because it will circumvent states' authority and urges Congress to reject the act. The joint resolution directs that a copy of the resolution be sent to the Governor, the Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives, the President of the U.S. Senate, and the President of the United States.
