15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
16 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19 the repeal of Sections 3 and 4 of Article XXV of the Constitution of
20 the State of Oklahoma which relate to the Oklahoma Public Welfare
21 Commission and the Director of Public Welfare.

22 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
23 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
24 the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of

1 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 6 to Article XXV thereof, to read
2 as follows:

3 Section 6. The Legislature shall have the authority and duty to
4 determine the composition and duties of the Human Services
5 Commission.

6 SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
7 amendment as set forth in SECTION 2 of this resolution shall be in
8 the following form:

11 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

12 This measure amends the State Constitution. It provides for the
13 repeal of Sections 3 and 4 of Article 25 which relate to the
14 Oklahoma Public Welfare Commission and the Director of Public
15 Welfare. This measure grants the Legislature the authority to
16 oversee the Human Services Commission.

20 SECTION 4. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
21 immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and

23 SECTION 3 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the
24 Attorney General.
