22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 254 of Title 62, unless there is
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
5 for the retirement systems of the State of Oklahoma to be designated
6 the "Oklahoma State Retirement Systems Revolving Fund". The fund
7 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,
8 and shall consist of all monies received and placed in the fund for
9 the benefit of retired members and beneficiaries of the retirement
10 systems of the State of Oklahoma from such sources as may be
11 designated by law. Expenditures from the fund shall be made only
12 pursuant to legislative appropriation from the Oklahoma State
13 Retirement Systems Revolving Fund to pay for the cost of any
14 legislatively authorized cost-of-living adjustment for the retirees
15 or beneficiaries of the retirement systems of the State of Oklahoma
16 and to reduce the unfunded liabilities of any of the state
17 retirement systems.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

14 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-123 of Title 70, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma to be designated the
19 "Teachers' Retirement System Cost-of-Living Adjustment Revolving
20 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal
21 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
22 Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma from such sources as may be
23 designated by law. Expenditures from the fund shall be made only
24 pursuant to legislative appropriation from the Teachers' Retirement
System Cost-of-Living Revolving Fund to pay for the cost of any

2 | or beneficiaries of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.

3 | SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

4 | SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 | of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 | declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 | be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
