13 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
14 entire bill and insert

15 "An Act relating to technology center school
16 districts; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1-118.1,
17 which relates to building fund of technology center
18 school districts; allowing additional uses of
19 certain funds; providing an effective date; and
20 declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1-118.1, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 Section 1-118.1 The building fund of any technology center
school district shall consist of all monies derived from the

1 proceeds of a building fund levy ~~of~~ not to exceed five (5) mills in
2 any year, voted by the people of a school district pursuant to the
3 provisions of ~~Article X,~~ Section 10~~,~~ of Article X of the Oklahoma
4 Constitution, monies appropriated by the state for the purpose of
5 capital expenditures or projects, and monies donated to a school
6 district for the purpose of capital projects or improvements and may
7 be used for purchasing, providing, erecting, remodeling, repairing
8 or maintaining any of the following: school buildings, ~~for~~
9 ~~purchasing~~ furniture, computer systems and equipment and computer,
10 software for instructional and noninstructional purposes, ~~for~~
11 ~~repairing and maintaining computer systems and equipment,~~ for paying
12 energy and utility costs, ~~for purchasing~~ telecommunications
13 utilities and services, ~~for paying~~ fire and casualty insurance
14 premiums for school facilities, ~~for purchasing security systems,~~ ~~for~~
15 ~~paying salaries of security personnel,~~ student transportation,
16 grounds maintenance including parking lots and sidewalks,

22 hereby declared to be a current expense fund, but shall not be
23 considered a part of the general operating fund. No monies derived

2 Constitution may be placed in the building fund provided by this
3 section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1-118.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-118.1. The building fund of any technology center school district shall consist of all monies derived from the proceeds of a building fund levy ~~of~~ not to exceed five (5) mills in any year, voted by the people of a school district pursuant to the provisions of ~~Article X, Section 10,~~ Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, monies appropriated by the state for the purpose of capital expenditures or projects, and monies donated to a school district for the purpose of capital projects or improvements and may be used for purchasing, providing, erecting, remodeling, repairing or maintaining any of the following: school buildings, ~~for purchasing~~ computer systems and equipment ~~and computer,~~ software for instructional and noninstructional purposes, ~~for repairing and maintaining computer systems and equipment, for paying~~

1 energy and utility costs, ~~for purchasing~~ telecommunications
2 utilities and services, ~~for paying~~ fire and casualty insurance
3 premiums for school facilities, ~~for purchasing security systems, for~~
4 ~~paying salaries of security personnel,~~ student transportation,
5 grounds maintenance including parking lots and sidewalks,
6 instructional and maintenance equipment, or for one or more, or all,
7 of ~~such~~ these purposes. Proceeds of ~~such~~ the levies shall not be
8 required to be used during the year for which a levy is made but may
