16 It is the intent of the Legislature, given that since Fiscal  
17 Year 2009 the budget for the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs  
18 has been reduced by thirteen and nine-tenths percent (13.9%), that  
19 an appropriation be made to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans  
20 Affairs in an amount as may be necessary to perform all duties and  
21 services to include: health services and long-term skilled care,  
22 housing, adult day care, psychiatric services, and field service  
23 counseling in the filing of claims for U.S. Department of Veterans  
24 Affairs and state benefits."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
12 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

13 It is the intent of the Legislature that an appropriation be  
14 made to the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission in an amount as may  
15 be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Commission by  
16 law.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
