12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
13 entire bill and insert

14 "An act relating to investigations; amending 74 O.S.
15 2011, Section 360.17, which relates to jurisdiction
16 of campus police officers; requiring notice to
17 district attorney for certain crimes; requiring
18 notice of completion of investigation; and providing
19 an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 360.17, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 360.17 A. The jurisdiction of campus police officers
24 includes the campus and pursuant to an agreement authorized by this
act, the highways, streets, roads, alleys, easements, and other

1 public ways immediately adjacent to their campus and any other areas
2 authorized by such agreement. This delineation of jurisdiction,
3 however, shall not be understood as limiting the completion of any
4 necessary enforcement activities which began within these
5 jurisdictions and are in compliance with the agreements made with
6 the municipality or county sheriff pursuant to this act. In the
7 absence of an agreement, only those law enforcement activities which
8 began on campus may be completed off campus and such activities must
9 be completed in a timely manner. Such law enforcement activities
10 shall only be authorized if the campus police have coordinated the
11 activities with the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction
12 in that off campus area. In addition, a campus police officer shall
13 have jurisdiction in other locations pursuant to an agreement
14 authorized by this act. Such agreement may authorize the chief
15 administrative officer of the law enforcement agency to request
16 assistance pursuant to the agreement. Campus police officers,
17 commissioned pursuant to this act, shall have the same powers,
18 liabilities, and immunities as sheriffs or police officers within
19 their jurisdiction.

20 B. As limited by law, the provisions of this section, and the
21 governing board, a CLEET certified campus police officer shall have
22 the authority to enforce:

23 1. State criminal statutes;

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1 2. Municipal ordinances, if authorized by an agreement with the
2 municipality; and

3 3. Rules and regulations of the school or institution of higher
4 education employing such campus police officer.

5 C. As limited by law, the provisions of this section, and the
6 governing board, the campus police department shall have the same
7 authority as a municipal police department.

8 D. Campus police departments formed by private institutions of
9 higher education pursuant to this act shall be deemed to be public
10 agencies in the State of Oklahoma for the limited purposes of
11 enforcing the criminal statutes of Oklahoma and making agreements
12 with local law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions of the
13 state pursuant to this act.

14 E. Upon the effective date of this act, all campus police
15 departments of this state shall notify the district attorney
16 situated in the county where the campus police department is located
17 of any complaint received by the campus police on any alleged crime
18 of rape or child abuse that is to have occurred within the
19 jurisdictional boundaries of the campus. Such notice shall be
20 submitted within three (3) days of receiving the complaint. Upon
21 completion of the investigation of the complaint, the campus police
22 shall notify the district attorney of the results of the
23 investigation and whether or not the complaint is going to be
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1 prosecuted pursuant to Section 360.21 of this title or if the
2 complaint was closed without prosecution.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.”

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

9 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 360.17, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 Section 360.17. A. The jurisdiction of campus police officers
12 includes the campus and pursuant to an agreement authorized by this
13 act, the highways, streets, roads, alleys, easements, and other
14 public ways immediately adjacent to their campus and any other areas
15 authorized by such agreement. This delineation of jurisdiction,
16 however, shall not be understood as limiting the completion of any
17 necessary enforcement activities which began within these
18 jurisdictions and are in compliance with the agreements made with
