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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 292, O.S.L.
23 2006, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 2007 (62 O.S.
24 Supp. 2010, Section 3109), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 3109. A. If an actuarial investigation of a retirement
2 bill having a fiscal impact is requested under Section 3108 of this
3 title, it shall be the duty of the Legislative Actuary to complete
4 or cause to be completed such actuarial investigation by not later
5 than ~~November~~ December 1 of the same year during which the request
6 for the actuarial investigation was made. The actuarial
7 investigation shall include, but shall not be limited to, findings
8 on the following factors as such factors are relevant to the
9 retirement bill under consideration:

10 1. The dollar amount of the unfunded actuarial accrued
11 liability which will result from the bill for the retirement system
12 affected by the bill;

13 2. The dollar amount of the annual normal cost which will
14 result from the bill for the retirement system affected by the bill;

15 3. A statement of the employer contribution rate currently in
16 effect for the retirement system affected by the bill;

17 4. A statement of the employer contribution rate necessary for
18 the retirement system to receive the required annual employer
19 contributions consistent with the most recently available valuation
20 report prepared by the actuary employed by the retirement system
21 affected by the bill;

22 5. A statement of the dollar amount of the increase in the
23 annual employer contribution, if an existing retirement system is
24 affected by the bill, or a statement of the total annual employer

1 contribution, if a new retirement system is established by the bill,
2 which will be necessary to maintain the retirement system affected
3 or established by the bill in an actuarially sound condition thereby
4 creating no increase in unfunded liability as defined by the most
5 recent actuarial evaluation of an existing system; and

6 6. A statement of the effect on the funded ratio for the
7 retirement system affected by the bill.

8 B. By not later than ~~November~~ December 1 of the same year that
9 the request for an actuarial investigation was made, the completed
10 actuarial investigation shall be submitted by the Legislative
11 Actuary to the chair of the committee who requested it along with a
12 summary of the actuarial investigation which shall include the
13 relevant findings specified in subsection A of this section.

14 C. The chair of the committee, upon receipt of the information
15 provided for under subsection B of this section, shall cause the
16 summary of the actuarial investigation to be attached to all copies
17 of the version of the bill submitted to the Legislative Actuary and
18 made available to committee members, other legislators and any other
19 interested parties. The original summary of the actuarial
20 investigation shall be attached to the original version of the
21 substitute bill, as amended by the committee under Section 3108 of
22 this title, if applicable, or to the original version of the bill as
23 introduced if the bill was not changed by the committee prior to its
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1 submission to the Legislative Actuary for an actuarial
2 investigation.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.”

1 B. By not later than ~~November~~ December 1 of the same year that
2 the request for an actuarial investigation was made, the completed
3 actuarial investigation shall be submitted by the Legislative
4 Actuary to the chair of the committee who requested it along with a
5 summary of the actuarial investigation which shall include the
6 relevant findings specified in subsection A of this section.

7 C. The chair of the committee, upon receipt of the information
8 provided for under subsection B of this section, shall cause the
9 summary of the actuarial investigation to be attached to all copies
10 of the version of the bill submitted to the Legislative Actuary and
11 made available to committee members, other legislators and any other
12 interested parties. The original summary of the actuarial
13 investigation shall be attached to the original version of the
14 substitute bill, as amended by the committee under Section 3108 of
15 this title, if applicable, or to the original version of the bill as
16 introduced if the bill was not changed by the committee prior to its
17 submission to the Legislative Actuary for an actuarial
18 investigation.

19 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

20 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
