14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
15 and insert

16 "An Act relating to dedication of memorial highways
17 and bridges; designating the Sergeant Schuyler B.

19 Andrew R. Looney Memorial Highway; designating the
20 Specialist Christopher D. Horton Memorial Highway;
21 designating the Sgt. Anthony Del Mar Peterson
22 Memorial Highway; designating the Captain John
23 Thompson Memorial Highway; designating the Barbara
24 S. Swineford Highway; designating the Merle D.
Swineford Highway; designating the Sergeant Bucky
Eisenberger Memorial Highway; designating the Pamela
Cleveland Argo Memorial Bridge; designating the
Specialist Jordan Morris Memorial Highway;
designating the Arthur and Gladys Baker Memorial
Bridge; designating the Sergeant Vincent L. C. Owens
Memorial Bridge; designating the Chappelle Family
Memorial Highway; designating the Lt. Colonel Warren

1 Pingleton Memorial Bridge; designating the Major
2 Bill Morgan Memorial Bridge; designating the Ronnie
3 Sumpter, Sonny Harris and Rhonda Howard Memorial
4 Bridge; designating the Specialist Micheal Phillips
5 Memorial Highway; designating the Aaron Harrison
6 Scott Memorial Bridge; designating the Corporal
7 Jared Shoemaker Memorial Bridge; designating the
8 Braggs Veterans Memorial Highway; designating the
9 1LT David Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway;
10 designating the Senator Gilmer J. Capps Highway;
11 requiring certain permanent markers; providing for
12 codification; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 86th Street North to 96th
19 Street North shall be designated as "Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch
20 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
21 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
22 name.

23 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 96th Street North to 106th
Street North shall be designated as "Specialist Andrew R. Looney
Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause

1 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
2 name.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 106th Street North to 116th
7 Street North shall be designated as "Specialist Christopher D.
8 Horton Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
9 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
10 that name.

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 76th Street North to 86th
15 Street North shall be designated as the "Sgt. Anthony Del Mar
16 Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
17 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
18 that name.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of U.S. Highway 64 from Hooker, Oklahoma, extending
23 east to Turpin, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Captain John
24 Thompson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall

1 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
2 that name.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The section of U.S. Highway 283 from Laverne, Oklahoma,
7 extending north to the intersection of U.S. Highway 283 and U.S.
8 Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Barbara S. Swineford
9 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

11 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of U.S. Highway 283 from Laverne, Oklahoma,
15 extending south to the intersection of U.S. Highway 283 and U.S.
16 Highway 412 shall be designated as the "Merle D. Swineford Highway".
17 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
18 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.119 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of highway from the junction of State Highway 99 and
23 State Highway 11 extending south to the Wynona municipal limits
24 shall be designated as the "Sergeant Bucky Eisenberger Memorial

1 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.120 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over the Canadian River on State Highway 2 north of
7 Whitefield, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Pamela Cleveland
8 Argo Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 bridge.

11 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.121 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of highway from the junction of State Highway 108
15 and State Highway 51 extending south to the Ripley municipal limits
16 shall be designated as "Specialist Jordan Morris Memorial Highway".
17 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
18 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.122 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over Big Lee Creek on State Highway 101 southwest of
23 Short shall be designated as the "Arthur and Gladys Baker Memorial
24

1 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.123 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over the Poteau River on State Highway 9 west of
7 Pocola shall be designated as the "Sergeant Vincent L. C. Owens
8 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 bridge.

11 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.124 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of State Highway 75 from Interstate 244 north to
15 56th Street North within the Tulsa municipal limits shall be
16 designated as "Chappelle Family Memorial Highway". The Department
17 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
18 placed on the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.125 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over Brushy Creek on State Highway 63 southwest of
23 Haileyville shall be designated as the "Lt. Colonel Warren Pingleton
24 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause

1 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
2 bridge.

3 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.126 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Brushy Creek on United States Highway 270
7 northwest of Haileyville shall be designated as the "Major Bill
8 Morgan Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
9 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
10 the bridge.

11 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.127 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The bridge over the Little Fourche Maline Creek on United States
15 Highway 270 east of the municipal limits of Panola shall be
16 designated as the "Ronnie Sumpter, Sonny Harris and Rhonda Howard
17 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers bearing those names to be placed on the
19 bridge.

20 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.128 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of Interstate 35 beginning at the northern municipal
24 limit of Ardmore and extending to the southern municipal limit of

1 Ardmore shall be designated as "Specialist Micheal Phillips Memorial
2 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
3 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

4 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.129 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over the Kiamichi River on U.S. Highway 271 located
8 one (1) mile south of the municipal limits of Clayton shall be
9 designated as the "Aaron Harrison Scott Memorial Bridge". The
10 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
11 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

12 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.130 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge over East 81st Street on U.S. Highway 169 within the
16 municipal limits of Tulsa shall be designated as the "Corporal Jared
17 Shoemaker Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
18 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
19 the bridge.

20 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.131 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of State Highway 10 beginning one (1) mile north of
24 the municipal limits of Braggs and extending one (1) mile south past

1 the southern municipal boundary of Braggs shall be designated as
2 "Braggs Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
4 on the highway bearing that name.

5 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.132 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The two-mile section of State Highway 37 in Moore, Oklahoma,
9 from the junction of State Highway 37 and Eastern Avenue extending
10 east to the junction of State Highway 37 and Sunnyslane Road shall be
11 designated as the "1LT David Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway".
12 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
13 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
14 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

15 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.133 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The portion of U.S. Highway 183 from the junction of U.S.
19 Highway 183 and U.S. Highway 62 extending south to Frederick,
20 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Senator Gilmer J. Capps
21 Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
23 permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.
