15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill  
16 and insert

17 "An Act relating to insurance coverage of military

insurance plan; requiring proof of certain coverage;  
20 providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1165 of Title 36, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 No employer shall require any employee who is retired from a  
5 branch of the United States military and has been provided with  
6 health coverage through a federal plan to participate in employer-  
7 sponsored health insurance coverage if the health insurance coverage  
8 requires a contribution from the employee. The employee shall  
9 provide to the employer before the beginning of each plan year proof  
10 of that coverage.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012."
