15 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
16 and insert

17 "An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
18 designating the Samuel R. Henderson Memorial Bridge;
19 designating the PFC A.T. Howell Memorial Bridge;
20 designating the SSGT Billy Elliott Memorial Highway;
21 designating the SSG John R. Bush Memorial Bridge;
22 designating the Harold Bell Memorial Bridge;
23 designating Larry Wade Memorial Highway; designating
24 the USAF Maj. Aubrey Eugene Stowers, Jr. Memorial
Bridge; providing for placement of permanent
markers; providing for codification; and declaring
an emergency.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
3 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.93 of Title 69, unless
4 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

5 The bridge crossing the Washita River on State Highway 74 north
6 of Maysville shall be designated as the "Samuel R. Henderson
7 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
8 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that
9 name.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.94 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge crossing Leader Creek on State Highway 3 in Coal
14 County shall be designated the "PFC A.T. Howell Memorial Bridge".
15 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
16 markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

17 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.95 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The portion of U.S. Highway 59 extending from the Poteau River
21 Bridge to the Heavener city limits shall be designated as the "SSGT
22 Billy Elliott Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
23 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
24 bearing that name.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.96 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge crossing Sandy Creek on State Highway 99 in Pontotoc
5 County shall be designated the "SSG John R. Bush Memorial Bridge".
6 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
7 markers to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

8 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in
9 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.97 of Title 69, unless there
10 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The bridge crossing Hudson Avenue on Interstate 244 in Tulsa
12 shall be designated the "Harold Bell Memorial Bridge". The
13 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
14 to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

15 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.98 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of State Highway 6 in Beckham County from
19 intersection of State Highway 6 and I-40 south to the intersection
20 of State Highway 6 and State Highway 152 shall be designated the
21 "Larry Wade Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
22 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
23 bearing that name.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.99 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge located approximately three (3) miles west of
5 Sentinel on State Highway 55 in Washita County shall be designated
6 as the "USAF Maj. Aubrey Eugene Stowers, Jr. Memorial Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed on the bridge bearing that name.

9 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
