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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3010 of Title 56, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
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1 The Department of Human Services shall develop a plan to create
2 greater efficiency in the delivery of services to older Oklahomans.
3 The plan shall be designed to result in no more than six Area
4 Agencies on Aging in the state. Savings realized from the
5 implementation of this plan shall be used to provide services to
6 eligible recipients. The plan shall provide for the continued
7 statewide delivery of services provided by Area Agencies on Aging.
8 The plan shall be developed in coordination with aging network
9 partners, including, but not limited to, Area Agencies on Aging,
10 service providers, senior advocates and elected officials. The plan
11 shall be developed no later than December 31, 2011, and shall
12 provide for implementation no later than July 1, 2012.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2011."
