BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 64 extending east to the junction of State Highway 11 and State Highway 38 shall be designated as the "U.S. Border Patrol Chief Donald R. Coppock Memorial Highway".

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 58 from the junction of State Highway 58 and State Highway 45 extending north to the junction of State Highway 58 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Coach Ray Troutt Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State
5 Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 77 extending east to Kaw City, Oklahoma,
6 shall be designated as the "Senator David Myers Memorial Highway".
7 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
9 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge crossing Grand Lake on U.S. Highway 59 in Delaware
14 County between Copeland, Oklahoma, and Grove, Oklahoma, shall be
15 designated as the "Veldo M. Goins Memorial Bridge". The Department
16 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
17 placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

18 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 from the junction of U.S. Highway
22 75 and U.S. Highway 412 extending south to the junction of U.S.
23 Highway 75 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Paul
24 Harvey Memorial Expressway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69

1 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
3 bearing that name.

4 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of U.S. Highway 70 from Broken Bow, Oklahoma,
8 extending south to Idabel, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
9 "Representative Rusty Farley Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the
10 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
11 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
12 upon the highway bearing that name.

13 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge crossing State Highway 50 north of Freedom, Oklahoma,
17 near the intersection of State Highway 50 and U.S. Highway 64 shall
18 be designated as the "Wesley and Maxine Nixon Bridge". The
19 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
20 to be placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

21 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.119 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The portion of State Highway 125 from the junction of State
2 Highway 125 and State Highway 85A extending south to where State
3 Highway 125 terminates on Monkey Island shall be designated as the
4 "Charles Davis Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
5 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
6 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
7 bearing that name.

8 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.120 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The portion of Interstate 35 from the junction of Interstate 35
12 and Indian Hills Road extending south to junction of Interstate 35
13 and State Highway 9 West shall be designated as the "Dr. James E.
14 and Representative Mina M. Hibdon Memorial Highway". Pursuant to
15 the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department
16 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
17 placed upon the highway bearing that name.

18 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.121 of Title 69, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The portion of Interstate 44 from the point one (1) mile north
22 of the intersection of Interstate 44 and U.S. Highway 62 extending
23 south to the intersection of Interstate 44 and State Highway 7 shall
24 be designated as the "Bill W. Burgess Jr. Highway". Pursuant to the

1 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
3 upon the highway bearing that name.

4 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.122 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of State Highway 48 in Creek County from the
8 junction of State Highway 48 and West 251st Street South extending
9 south to the junction of State Highway 48 and East 950 Road shall be
10 designated as the "Major Brice Clayton Coleman Memorial Highway".
11 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
12 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
13 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

14 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.123 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The portion of United States Highway 81 located within the
18 municipal limits of the City of Hennessey shall be designated as
19 "Senator Ralph J. Choate Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the
20 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
21 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
22 on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.124 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the junction of U.S.
5 Highway 75 and West 201st Street South extending south to Okmulgee,
6 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Trooper William McClendon
7 Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing
10 that name.

11 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.125 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 34 from the Dewey County and Custer
15 County line extending northward to the Canadian River shall be
16 designated as "Jimmy Harrel Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
17 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
18 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
19 bearing that name.

20 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.126 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The portion of State Highway 39 extending from the municipal
24 limits of the city of Asher to the municipal limits of the city of

1 Konawa shall be designated as the "Deputy Mike Roberts and Deputy
2 Tim Lowry Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69
3 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall
4 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway.

5 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.127 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge over an unnamed creek at Meadow Lake Park on US
9 Highway 81, south of the municipal limits of Enid shall be
10 designated as "Senator Robert Milacek Memorial Bridge". The
11 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
12 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

13 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.128 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge over Black Bear Creek on US Highway 77, north of the
17 municipal limits of Perry shall be designated as "Gordon Roesler
18 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
19 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
20 name.

21 SECTION 18. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
