

## CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT SUMMARY

General Subject Matter: State Government

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Removed language allowing Legislators to opt-out of health insurance benefits.

Section 6. Directs the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board (OSEEGIB) to contract with a vendor that offers a Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) compliant web-based, doctor patient mutual accountability incentive program.

√ Changes made in conference:

Sections 2-4. Allows active state employees who are currently covered by a separate group health insurance plan to opt out of the state's basic plan. Provides that employees opting out of coverage will receive \$150.00 a month in lieu of the flexible benefit amount the employee would be otherwise eligible to receive.

Section 5. Directs OSEEGIB and the Office of State Finance to make available a health savings account to all enrollees in the HealthChoice qualified high-deductible health plan.
