General Subject Matter: Utilities

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 3. Definition of 'identifying information' expanded to encompass any information that directly or indirectly identifies a customer. Definition of 'customer-identifiable usage data' expanded to include usage data that could be manipulated to identify a customer without extraordinary effort. Definition of 'standard usage data' modified to specify that this type of usage data is used internally.

Section 4. Utilization of customer-identifiable usage data for some purposes made subject to the approval of the Corporation Commission or certain boards of trustees.

Section 5. Requires electric utilities, to the extent feasible and upon written request, to provide the nonstandard usage data of the customer to the customer.

Section 6. Modifies language related to providing customer information to certain parties without customer consent by stipulating that this information may only be given to affiliates and third parties who are under contract, with certain limitations.

Section 8. Section added stipulating that the Corporation Commission or board of trustees, in certain instances, is to promulgate rules to implement the Act.

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
