General Subject Matter: State Government

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Section 5. Provides that certain shared leave may be accumulated in a payroll conversion bank by employees of agencies converting to a multi-monthly payroll system.

√ Changes made in conference:

Removed Section 3 of the engrossed House bill relating to the use of the Trip Optimizer System.

Section 6. Requires copies of any audit, agreed upon procedure report or other attestation engagement report that is required to be filed with the State Auditor and Inspector to be submitted in electronic format and made available to the public on the Auditor's website.

Section 7. Directs the Superintendent of Public Instruction to publish on a website a listing of all expenses paid by the Department of Education necessary to sponsor or participate in meetings or training sessions, and authorizes the Superintendent to enter into contracts for the payment of expenses necessary to sponsor or participate in such meetings or training sessions. This section also limits the amount of the cost of food for certain persons attending the meetings to the total daily rate provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
