General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

None

√ Changes made in conference:

Adds language to Section 1 providing that upon presentation of appropriate proof of loss documentation, the transfer of title may be processed as one title transaction when the insurer also requests a salvage or junk title. Provides that the fee for the transfer is to be \$22, with \$2 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

Adds a new Section 2 clarifying that upon presentation of appropriate proof of loss documentation, the transfer of title may be processed as one title transaction when the insurer also requests a salvage or junk title.

Added new Section 3 which changes the degree of consanguinity which prohibits the appointment as a tag agent if the person is related to a member of the Legislature from within the third degree of consanguinity to within the second degree of consanguinity.

Adds a new Section 4 stating that the fee retention amount for certificates of title to an insurer is \$4.50 when the insurer has paid the \$22 fee for a junk or salvage title.
