General Subject Matter: Mental health; persons requiring treatment

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Section 3. Deleting from the existing statutory definition of dangerous person the phrase “one who poses a substantial risk of harm to self or others” and replacing it with “a person requiring treatment.”

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 1. Modifying the definition of person requiring treatment by providing that the individual must pose a risk of *immediate* physical harm to self or others as opposed to the standard in the engrossed version that the risk be *in the near future*.
