Section 1. Defines prospective employee as an individual who has received an offer of temporary employment by a school district pending results of a national criminal history record check. Districts may temporarily employ people for a maximum of 60 days while awaiting results. School districts are excluded from liability, except in negligence, when employing prospective employees during the 60-day period.
