General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 1: Outlines state population and ideal House district population and describes delineation of information for House districts by Census geography.

Section 2: Renumbered as Section 6.

New Section 2 provides for correction of errors and adjustment to prevent zero-population precincts.

Section 3: Delineates 101 House districts by Census geography and reflects population totals.

Section 4: Requires the Department of Transportation to publish House District maps, as prepared by House staff, to provide to the State Election Board.

Section 5: Provides for State Representative terms and establishes effective date of act for state House districts.
