General Subject Matter: State vehicles

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

None

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 1: Exempts vehicles used by CLEET-certified officers and state employees primarily employed in investigative activities from the provisions in Section 1.

**Removes** Section 7 of the engrossed HB, which placed the Fleet Management Division in charge of all Department of Public Safety, Department of Transportation, Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, OSBI, and Higher Ed vehicles.

**Removes** Section 8 of the engrossed HB, which stated that all acquisitions of vehicles under 10,000 pounds required approval by the State Fleet Manager and mandated agencies to submit an updated inventory report to the State Fleet Manager after acquiring a vehicle.

Section 8: States that each state agency, regardless of the exceptions granted in Section 78 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, must provide a motor vehicle inventory to the Office of Public Affairs when requested by the Fleet Management Division.
