General Subject Matter: State government

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Sections 2: **Removes** the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission and the Office of the State Bond Advisor from the State Government Administrative Process Consolidation and Reorganization Reform Act of 2012.

Section 3: **Removes** language stating employees of the consolidated agencies will see their sick and annual leave, holidays, unemployment, and workers' compensation benefits transfer to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

Section 14: **Adds** details pertaining to the Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Board, specifying the compensation and expense reimbursements for members, removal of a member, what constitutes a quorum, and establishes a grievance panel.

Section 18: **Adds** details regarding employee flexible benefit allowances beginning January 1, 2013.

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 20: States that the Director of OSF will develop processes and procedures to guide state agencies in the preparation of performance metric and that the agencies must provide information as required by the Director to assist in developing these metrics. The performance metrics will be reviewed annually and will be published online.

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
