Section 2: Changes the name of the task force to the Rethinking Special Education Competency and Transition Task Force. The task force will focus on improved educational services and outcomes and meaningful postsecondary transition plans. The task force should study how special education services can be enhanced through collaboration models, what are the most salient issues when a parent files a complaint, teacher preparation for accommodating students with learning differences, safeguards to assure annual progress, barriers for students who graduate and want to attend postsecondary education classes, options for creating a statewide special education entity and other states' models. Makeup of the task force is modified to include 24 members.

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
