11 An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health
12 and Substance Abuse Services; identifying funds;
13 requiring budgeting and expenditure for certain
14 services; requiring memorandum of understanding;
15 stating requirements of memorandum; providing for
16 review and approval of memorandum; and declaring
17 an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated in Sections 85 and 87 of
20 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1975 of the 2nd Session of the 53rd
21 Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Mental Health and Substance
22 Abuse Services shall budget and expend for the fiscal year ending
23 June 30, 2013, for services related to behavioral health under Title
24 XIX of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 1396 et seq., no
less than One Hundred Eighteen Million Four Hundred Ninety-two

1 Thousand Seven Hundred Four Dollars (\$118,492,704.00). This section
2 identifies funding for the Department of Mental Health and Substance
3 Abuse Services to provide behavioral health services previously
4 funded through the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

5 SECTION 2. No later than June 30, 2012, the Department of
6 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the Oklahoma Health
7 Care Authority shall execute a memorandum of understanding, to be
8 reviewed and approved by the Director of the Office of State
9 Finance, outlining respective roles and responsibilities, including
10 funding and FTE, related to the management and purchasing of
11 behavioral health services under Title XIX of the Social Security
12 Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 1396 et seq. If the Department of Mental
13 Health and Substance Abuse Services and the Oklahoma Health Care
14 Authority cannot agree on the specific language of the memorandum of
15 understanding, the Director of the Office of State Finance, on
16 behalf of the Governor, shall make the final determination,
17 providing nothing in the memorandum of understanding will conflict
18 with federal regulations.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
