7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
9 Investigation; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1,
10 which relates to the Internet Crimes Against Children
11 unit; authorizing the Director of the Bureau to enter
12 into certain cooperative agreements for the purpose
13 of appointing certain agents to assist the unit;
14 making such agents employees and commissioned law
15 enforcement officers of certain law enforcement
16 agencies; providing for certain powers of the agents;
17 providing for renewal, suspension or revocation of
18 the agreements; providing that agents serve at the
19 discretion and will of the Director of the Bureau;
20 and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 151.1, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24 Section 151.1. A. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
(OSBI) shall establish an Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC)
unit for the primary purpose of investigating Internet crimes
committed against children, including, but not limited to, offenses
related to child pornography and solicitation of minors for

1 pornography, prostitution or sex-related offenses. The unit shall
2 additionally promote safe Internet use among children and their
3 parents by various media or printed-material campaigns or by
4 offering educational programs to schools or communities throughout
5 this state. The Bureau shall employ sufficient employees to
6 investigate and implement the ICAC unit.

7 B. The Director of the OSBI is hereby authorized to enter into
8 local cooperative agreements with local law enforcement agencies for
9 the purpose of appointing ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents to assist
10 the ICAC unit of the OSBI. ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents shall
11 be employees and commissioned law enforcement officers of the local
12 law enforcement agency entering into agreement with the Oklahoma
13 State Bureau of Investigation and shall not be employees of the
14 OSBI. ICAC Affiliate Task Force Agents shall have general peace
15 officer powers throughout the state, including the authority to
16 arrest, for the purpose of investigating Internet crimes committed
17 against children, including, but not limited to, offenses related to
18 child pornography and solicitation of minors for pornography,
19 prostitution or sex-related offenses and to promote safe Internet
20 use among children and their parents by various media or printed-
21 material campaigns or by offering educational programs to schools or
22 communities throughout Oklahoma. The Director of the OSBI may
23 renew, suspend or revoke any agreement appointing an ICAC Affiliate
24 Task Force Agent at any time. Individuals serve as ICAC Affiliate

1 Task Force Agents solely at the discretion and will of the OSBI
2 Director.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
