8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
9 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.26, which relates to the
10 Oklahoma Self Defense Act; requiring certain
11 concealed license under certain circumstances; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.26, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1290.26.

17 RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AUTHORITY

18 The State of Oklahoma hereby recognizes any valid concealed
19 carry weapons permit or license issued by another state. Any person
20 entering this state in possession of a firearm authorized for
21 concealed carry upon the authority and license of another state is
22 authorized to continue to carry a concealed firearm and license in
23 this state; provided the license from the other state remains valid.
24 The firearm must be carried fully concealed from detection and view,

1 and upon coming in contact with any peace officer of this state, the
2 person must disclose the fact that he or she is in possession of a
3 concealed firearm pursuant to a valid concealed carry weapons permit
4 or license issued in another state. Any person who is twenty-one
5 (21) years of age or older having a valid firearm license from
6 another state ~~may apply for a concealed handgun license in this~~
7 ~~state immediately upon establishing~~ who establishes a residence in
8 this state or is a resident of this state shall also have a valid
9 license to carry a concealed handgun as authorized by the Oklahoma
10 Self Defense Act in order to carry a concealed handgun in this
11 state.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
