11 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2011,  
12 Section 601.3, which relates to the Oklahoma  
13 Commission on Children and Youth; modifying powers and  
14 duties of Commission; repealing 10 O.S. 2011,  
15 Sections 630.1, 630.2 and 630.3, which relate to the  
16 Coordinated Database System for Children Act;  
17 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
18 emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2011, Section 601.3, is  
21 amended to read as follows:

22 Section 601.3. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth is  
23 hereby authorized and directed to:

24 1. Establish and maintain the Office of Planning and  
Coordination for Services to Children and Youth;

1           2. Establish and maintain the Office of Juvenile System  
2 Oversight;

3           3. Designate community partnership districts for services to  
4 children and youth and, within the limitations of available funds,  
5 whether appropriated or otherwise available, provide staff,  
6 technical assistance and other assistance as necessary and  
7 appropriate to the district boards; ~~and~~

8           4. Establish a system of certification in accordance with the  
9 Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act for the shelters  
10 managed and operated by the Department of Human Services pursuant to  
11 Section ~~7004-3.1~~ 1-9-111 of ~~this title~~ Title 10A of the Oklahoma  
12 Statutes; and

13           5. Establish services for the children of incarcerated parents.  
14 Duties designed to improve the lives of children of incarcerated  
15 parents shall include:

- 16           a. coordinating research,  
17           b. collecting data,  
18           c. creating a resource clearinghouse,  
19           d. developing an educational toolkit describing services  
20           available to children of incarcerated parents, and  
21           e. coordinating an advisory committee to work  
22           collaboratively with agencies and service providers to  
23           better meet the needs and improve the quality of life  
24           for children of incarcerated parents.

1 SECTION 2. REPEALER 10 O.S. 2011, Sections 630.1, 630.2  
2 and 630.3, are hereby repealed.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

4 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
