8 An Act relating to agriculture; stating legislative  
9 intent that an international airport in Oklahoma  
10 apply and receive approval from the United States  
11 Department of Agriculture and the United States  
12 Customs and Border Patrol to provide international  
13 and domestic livestock import and export functions;  
14 requiring certain certification; providing for  
15 report; providing for codification; and providing an  
16 effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19-2 of Title 2, unless there is  
20 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that an  
22 international airport in the state of Oklahoma apply and receive  
23 approval from the United States Department of Agriculture and the  
24 United States Customs and Border Patrol to provide international and  
25 domestic livestock and livestock products import and export  
26 functions. The cities of Oklahoma City and Tulsa and their

1 respective airports shall cooperate with the Oklahoma Department of  
2 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the United States Department of  
3 Agriculture and the United States Customs and Border Patrol to  
4 achieve this intent. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,  
5 and Forestry shall provide a progress report to the President Pro  
6 Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives  
7 and the Governor no later than December 1, 2012.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.

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
