8 An Act relating to the Joint Task Force on the Grand  
9 River Dam Authority; amending Section 3, Chapter 192,  
10 O.S.L. 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3),  
11 which relates to the task force; modifying membership  
12 of the task force; requiring certain biennial  
13 meetings; authorizing additional meetings; requiring  
14 certain annual report to the task force; terminating  
15 membership of certain task force members; requiring  
16 appointment of new members by certain date; providing  
17 for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L.  
20 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3), is amended to read as  
21 follows:

22 Section 863.3 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative  
23 Task Force on the Grand River Dam Authority for the purpose of  
24 studying the functions, activities, policies, procedures and  
expenditures performed by the district and any related issues the  
task force deems appropriate. Members of the task force shall be  
appointed in January of each year following a state general election

1 by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the  
2 House of Representatives. Membership shall be made up of ~~all Senate~~  
3 ~~and House members whose legislative districts include a portion of~~  
4 ~~the Grand River Dam Authority district~~ five members of the Senate  
5 and five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the  
6 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
7 Representatives, respectively. The President Pro Tempore and  
8 Speaker shall each designate one of their members to be cochairs of  
9 the task force. The task force shall be required to meet at least  
10 once biennially during the first session of each new legislature.  
11 Additional meetings may be called as the cochairs determine  
12 necessary. Meetings of the task force shall be called by the  
13 cochairs. A majority of the appointed members shall constitute a  
14 quorum for any meeting of the task force. Staffing assistance shall  
15 be provided by the staff of the Senate and House of Representatives.

16 B. The members of the task force created herein shall continue  
17 to serve until new members are appointed pursuant to the provisions  
18 of subsection A of this section. ~~Such~~ The task force is authorized  
19 to adopt any recommendations or issue any report it deems necessary.  
20 Any recommendations or reports shall be approved by a majority of  
21 the appointed members. Copies of any recommendations or reports  
22 issued by the task force shall be distributed to the Governor, the  
23 President Pro Tempore of the Senate ~~and,~~ the Speaker of the House of  
24 Representatives, the members of the Grand River Dam Authority Board

1 of Directors and the General Manager of the Grand River Dam  
2 Authority.

3 C. The Grand River Dam Authority shall annually provide a copy  
4 of the district's most recent annual report to the members of the  
5 task force in addition to any information requested pursuant to the  
6 provisions of this section.

7 D. Members serving on ~~this~~ the task force shall be entitled to  
8 travel reimbursement as provided by Section 456 of Title 74 of the  
9 Oklahoma Statutes.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
11 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

12 Members serving on the Grand River Dam Authority Task Force  
13 appointed prior to the effective date of this act are hereby  
14 terminated. Appointments of new members made pursuant to Section  
15 863.3 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be made within  
16 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act. Future  
17 appointments of task force members shall be made in January of each  
18 year following a state general election.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
