

10 An Act relating to counties; amending 19 O.S. 2011,
11 Sections 130.2 and 130.6, which relate to the
12 Commission on County Government Personnel Education
13 and Training; modifying duties of the Commission;
14 modifying payment of expenses; providing an effective
15 date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.2, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 130.2 The duties of the Commission shall be:

20 1. To oversee a professional development program for training
21 Oklahoma county commissioners, county clerks, county treasurers,
22 county assessors, court clerks, their deputies and employees, county
23 sheriffs, excise board members, and other political subdivisions

1 through the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State
2 University;

3 2. To provide guidance to the Cooperative Extension Service in
4 designing curricula to be used in educational programs and
5 materials;

6 3. To identify needs and set priorities for research to be
7 conducted in cooperation with the Cooperative Extension Service in
8 areas relevant to the study and improvement of Oklahoma county
9 government and its functions and to accept gifts and grants for such
10 purposes;

11 4. To cooperate with the advisory boards authorized in Section
12 130.4 of this title in determining the educational needs of county
13 officials and their employees so that they can perform their duties
14 and responsibilities efficiently and professionally; and

15 5. To contract with the Cooperative Extension Service at
16 Oklahoma State University to administer personnel education and
17 training for counties and other political subdivisions.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 130.6, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 130.6 A. 1. Any professional or clerical support
21 staff required by the Commission on County Government Personnel
22 Education and Training shall be provided through the Cooperative
23 Extension Service.

1 2. The training programs developed pursuant to ~~Sections~~ Section
2 130.1 ~~through 130.7~~ et seq. of this title shall not interfere with
3 or duplicate any other existing training programs for county
4 government personnel.

5 B. ~~All expenses~~ Expenses incurred in the performance of the
6 duties imposed upon the Commission by law shall primarily be paid
7 out of funds appropriated ~~or otherwise made available~~ to the Office
8 of the State Auditor and Inspector and may also be paid by the
9 collection of training expenses paid by the counties directly to the
10 Cooperative Extension Service.

11 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

12 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
